PILOT PUMPING TEST FOR THE GROUNDWATER OPERABLE UNIT (GWOU) AT THE WELDON SPRING SITE

Provided for your information is the above-referenced document. This plan discusses the testing program for investigating the aquifer response to groundwater pumping and withdrawal at the Weldon Spring Chemical Plant area. The plan designates that a pumping well and several piezometers be installed, groundwater be sampled for contaminants of concern (COC) identified for the GWOU and other specific parameters, and testing be conducted to determine aquifer properties. This information will be used to further evaluate the possibility of treating these COCs prior to submittal of the draft final Proposed Plan for the Groundwater Operable Unit.
