The administrative record includes documents which form the basis for the selection of any remedial action at this site. Documents now in the record include preliminary assessment reports and site investigation reports, validated sampling data, RI/FS work plan, and the community relations plan. These additional documents may include, but are not limited to, the RI/FS-EIS report, other technical reports, additional validated sampling data, comments and new data submitted by interested persons, and DOE responses to comments.
