Dear Commissioner Parker:

I am writing in response to your letter which expressed concern about the safety of the EPA directed Characterization Program.

The Department of Energy (DOE) and the County Commission have the same basic goal and objective for the project; assuring the public health and safety of the citizens of St. Charles County by providing for appropriate long-term management of the Weldon Spring Site materials. Please be assured that any interim actions or investigative studies will be carried out in the safest manner possible.

As the DOE and its contractor begin initial cleanup and ultimate remedial action you have my personal commitment that only the best available technologies will be employed and the highest safety standards imposed. That includes not only worker safety but the safety of the citizens of St. Charles County, the environment, and the County well field. I share your concern that pressure for a rapid cleanup could compromise environmental safety. However, at no time will the Department allow personal or environmental safety standards to be compromised to maintain the project schedule.

As I have committed in the past, the DOE will keep the County informed of future plans, current status, and progress. In that regard, I or any members of my staff are available at your request to provide that information.


